



ELECTION NIGHT TRUE OR FALSE? ANSWER KEY

The presidential election can result in a tie.

Answer: True. The presidential election can result in a 269-269 electoral vote tie. If that happens, the newly elected members of the House of Representatives would vote for president.

Puerto Rico has 1 electoral vote

False. Puerto Rico has 0 electoral votes.

Kamala Harris went to high school in Canada

Answer: True. Kamala Harris went to high school in Montreal, Quebec, Canada.

Tim Walz was a geography teacher

Answer: True. Tim Walz was a geography teacher at Mankato West High School in Mankato, Minnesota.

JD Vance's full name is James Daniel Vance

Answer: False. JD Vance's full name is James David Vance.

Donald Trump is 81 years old

Answer: False. Donald Trump is 78 years old.

Both Richard Nixon and Ronald Reagan won 49 out of 50 states

Answer: True. In 1972, Richard Nixon won 49 states and 520 electoral votes. In 1984, Ronald Reagan won 49 states and 525 electoral votes.

In order to run for president, a candidate must have been a US resident for 20 years

Answer: False. A candidate must have been a US resident for 14 years.

Hillary Clinton was the first woman to run for president

Answer: False. Victoria Woodhull was the first woman to formally run for president in 1872.

George Washington was unanimously elected in the first presidential election

Answer: True. In 1789, the first presidential election, George Washington was unanimously elected president with 69 electoral votes.
